

Position Title: Reuse Specialist

Home ReSource is seeking a Reuse Specialist to join our organizational team. The reuse specialist will learn and employ a wide range of skills from sorting, processing, and stocking, building material identification and basic construction to reuse in a business that engages community while contributing to a sustainable economy. The ideal candidate will work to further the mission, vision, and culture of Home ReSource, operate cooperatively and safely, communicate positively, and be excited to learn with and contribute to our growing organization.

**Basic Activities:** Evaluating donated materials according to current acceptance policies; processing, sorting, and stocking public donations; maintaining orderly and safe storage of materials, work spaces, and equipment; safe conduct of self; move materials throughout the store and to assist customers; answering questions regarding material availability, location, and the mission of the organization.

**Essential Qualifications:** Work as a team member across all aspects of the organization; ability to interact with people of diverse cultural and economic backgrounds in a respectful, positive manner; remain calm and positive in a fast-paced work environment; remain aware of safety concerns and make safe choices in changing conditions, uneven ground and irregular storage facilities; ability to safely lift bulky and heavy items; commitment to resource conservation; willingness to work hard and learn new skills; commitment to the organizational mission; and ability to work independently and as a team. Successful applicants will be required to comply with policies outlined in the Home ReSource Employee Manual.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Experience in customer service in a busy retail environment; knowledge of construction materials and techniques; experience with forklift and power tools operation; building materials use and practices; basic computer programs and Point of Sale. Ability to prioritize tasks and direct self and others to work toward big picture goals; excellent people skills; strong written, verbal and math skills; state of MT driver's license.

Hours/Week: 30 to 40 hours/week, preference to those who can commit to Saturday and/or Sunday
